



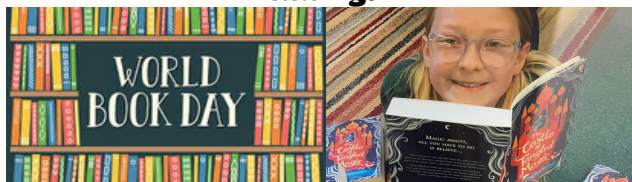

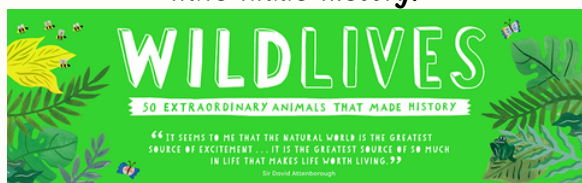


We also have parents evening on Wednesday 1st March, you should have all received your 10 minute timeslot via email - if you have not then please get in touch with Mrs Palmer.
