NEWS FROM FARTHING WOOD:

Farthing Wood Class have been writing & following craft instructions to make their own artwork showing skylines during The Blitz in the Second World War. Children were able to follow their instructions to make their own unique piece of artwork. They then began to paint their own background, designed silhouettes of the buildings and houses they wish to add to their pictures, making each piece of artwork different. We explored the concept of colour: Experimenting and exploring hues, tones and saturation through increasingly subtle mixing and control. We explored the concept of colour: to understand and visually articulate understanding of the weight and temperature of colour; beginning to apply this in relation to the subject. We explored the concept of colour: identifying and using a code or convention in the use of colour with specific reference to its aesthetic, cultural and historical significance.

The Blitz was an intense bombing campaign where Nazi Germany attacked Britain's cities.This took place during World War Two, from September 1940 to May 1941. Our work will be on display in our classroom & please watch our video on the school Facebook page & website.
