## COMING UP NEXT WEEK

May 9th - 12th: Year 6 End of Key Stage 2 Standard Assessment Tests (otherwise known as SATs) check your child's knowledge of the National Curriculum. The tests are compulsory for Year 6 students and they're used to assess your child against age-related expectations. Your child is expected to sit every test. Therefore, we must be informed immediately if you think your child may be absent from school during any of these tests dates as alternative arrangements (for them sitting the tests) will need to be made as there are strict guidelines we must follow.



### The Timetable for Year 6 SATs:

1. Tuesday 9 May 2023: Spelling, Punctuation & Grammar – Paper 1.
2. Tuesday 9 May 2023: Spelling Punctuation & Grammar – Paper 2.
3. Wednesday 10 May 2023: English Reading.
4. Thursday 11 May 2023: Maths Paper 1 (Arithmetic)
5. Thursday 11 May 2023: Maths Paper 2 (Reasoning)
6. Friday 12 May 2023: Maths Paper 3 (Reasoning)
