### Victorians

The Victorian era is named after Queen Victoria who was queen from 1837 – 1901. People who lived during this time are known as The Victorians.

### Estate

Land and property owned by one person.

### Great House

The main house.

### North, East, South & West Wing

A section of a building.

### Gatehouse

A building connected with the gateway of a Great House.

### Gallery

The long, narrow room at Lanhydrock. The ceiling is decorated with pictures of animals and birds.

### Portraits



A picture of a person, usually showing their face. The Agar-Robartes children were often painted with their pets.

### Servants

Servants were people who worked to prepare food, wash laundry and look after the house and gardens for the Agar-Robartes family.
