## LONDON MARATHON FUNDRAISER FOR PANCREATIC CANCER RESEARCH FUND

A Trewidland School parent is preparing to take on her first marathon, raising vital funds for the Pancreatic Cancer Research Fund (PCRF). Ali O'Hora, mum of Reuben in Year 2, was one of the lucky runners to secure a sought-after ballot place in the prestigious TCS London Marathon, taking place this year on 2<sup>nd</sup> October, and has chosen to run for a charity close to the family's heart.

Reuben's great uncle, Paul O'Hora, sadly passed away last year after a short battle with pancreatic cancer and the disease has a very low survival rate of just 3%. Research work to improve this statistic is crucial and, with the cause receiving less than 2% of the UK's national spend on cancer research, the PCRF relies on much-needed donations to support its work to aid earlier diagnosis.

We are now excited to offer extended wrap around care for all of our pupils (including pre-school)

<u>Breakfast club 8-8:45am</u> at £3 per session including breakfast and a drink <u>Late Owls, end of school until 5pm</u> at £7 per session including a drink and a snack <u>Late Owls plus, end of school until 5:30pm</u> at £10 per session including a snack and a drink.

When booking before and after school provision together Monday-Thursday we can offer:

- Breakfast club and late owls discount £9.50 per day, overall cost \*£38 per week.
- Breakfast club and late owls plus discount £12.50 per day, overall cost \*£50 per week
- $\star$  all four days need to be booked for the discount rate to apply.

Fridays are charged at the normal rate and are available to 5pm only. All bookings can be made and paid for through the school office and we ask that these are made at least one full working day in advance to arrange staff cover.
