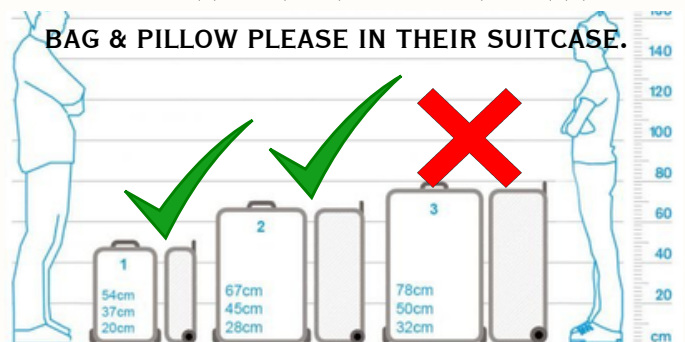

Wednesdays for Pre-school & Reception

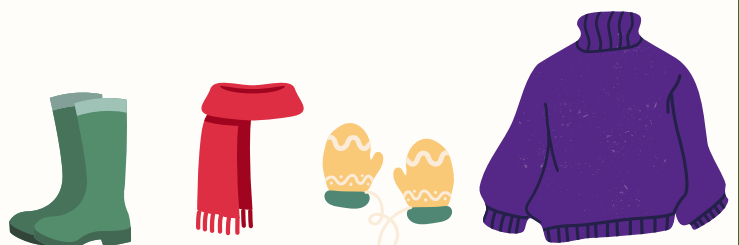
Thursdays for Years 3, 4, 5 & 6

Dear Parent / Carer

Regular and punctual attendance at school is a legal requirement and is essential if pupils are to maximise their educational opportunities.

Trewidland School is committed to providing an education of the highest quality for all its students and recognises that can only be achieved by supporting and promoting excellent school attendance by all. Only by attending school regularly, and punctually, will children be able to take full advantage of the educational opportunities available to them.

Trewidland School does not support holidays taken during term time. Holidays in term time are not a universal entitlement. They are only granted at the discretion of the Headteacher and only in exceptional circumstances.

If Parents/Carers wish to take a student on holiday in term time, they should fill in a leave of absence request form, found on the school website. This form can be completed online or printed and handed to the Attendance Office within the main reception area.

Parents/Carers who take their child out of School/College for a holiday without authorisation could receive a Fixed Penalty Notice

If your child is absent from school without authorisation, you will be committing an offence under the Education Act 1996. We may submit a request to Cornwall Council for a Penalty Notice to be issued, in accordance with Sections 444A and 444B of the said Act. Penalty Notices are issued per liable parent, per child and each carry a fine of £60 if paid within 21 days or £120 if paid after this but within 28 days. Failure to pay the Penalty Notice may result in legal action. Absence not authorised by the school may result in a prosecution in the Magistrates' Court under Section 444(1) or Section 444(1A) of the Education Act 1996, leading to a fine of up to £2,500 and/or a custodial sentence. Cornwall Council may also apply for the costs incurred in taking the matter to Court.
