We have been thinking about report writing in Class 2 and carefully considering the features of a report. Structures are really important for this type of writing and so we have been considering this carefully. In Class 1 we have been working hard on our phonics – and sounds too. Both Classes are hives of activity and it is wonderful to see so much engagement in the learning activities we provide.

In our foundation lessons, the children in Class 2 have continued to develop their understanding of charcoal as a material and seen how the Stone Age people would have used it to create images. In Class 1, we have been thinking about the different ways to join materials as we consider creating habitats.

In our assemblies this week we celebrated the achievement in both classes before considering the 'Composer of the Term' – Hans Zimmer – and listened to some of the music he created. The instrumental tones, mainly using the piano, are indeed very soothing and relaxing to listen to. I'm going to be sure to play some of his music in the car! Perhaps you could discuss Hans with your child and get them to tell you all about the music we listen to in assembly.

Clubs started this week too. Drawing club was great! We thought about ways to create cartoon pizza slices and considered how to show personality through mark making. Excellent stuff – I'm looking forward to the next one already.




