We've reached the end of another term- and what a term it has been! There's been trips, swimming lessons, statutory assessments and lots of learning too.

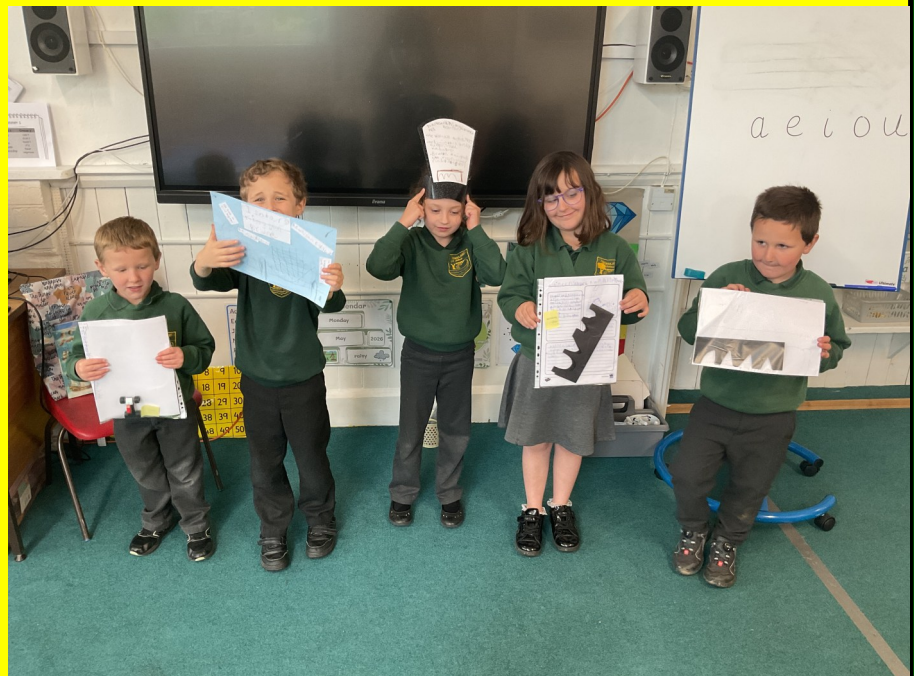

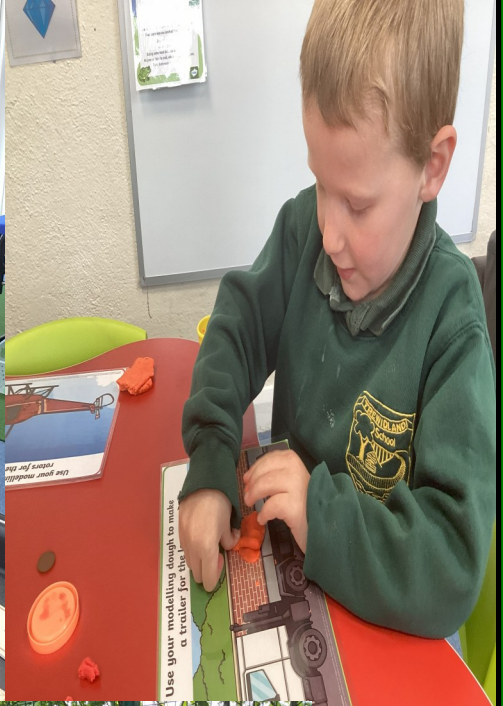
