Topic: Once Upon a Time Term: Autumn 1

Spellings

Your children will be given their spellings on a Monday they will practice these in school 3 times a week and need to practice at home. They will then complete a spelling quiz on a Friday.

Counting

Practise counting and writing numbers from 0-20 forwards and backwards.

Practise number bonds from 0-10 and 0-20
($1 + 9 = 10$ $11 + 9 = 20$ etc)

Practise counting in 2s to 20.

Practise making groups of 2 to 20 using socks, shoes, toys, bottle tops or counters.

Topic Project Activities

Complete one of the following activities with a “Get involved” attitude demonstrating your new SECRET Skill:

- Use a box to make the kitchen from Goldilocks and the Three Bears.
- Use a box to make Goldilock’s own home (which we don’t actually get to see in the story).
- Make a model of the forest in which the Three Bears live.
- Draw or describe your own fairy tale villain or hero

Reading

Read your RWI book daily for 5-10 minutes with a grown up. Warm-up each time with your sounds at the front of the book and make sure you do the comprehension questions and speed words at the back too. You can spread these activities out across the week that you have the book for. Make sure your grown-up writes a comment in your reading record each time you read to ensure you get your Class Dojo points. You could get 7 every week!
